

Lie detector tests accused child killer

A MAN twice freed over the murder more than 30 years ago of a Queensland toddler has taken a lie detector test to try and prove his innocence.

Raymond John Carroll, who is now 48, was convicted and twice acquitted over the murder of 17-month-old Deirdre Kennedy in Ipswich in 1973.

On the 33rd anniversary of the killing Carroll took a lie detector test for the Nine Network's 60 Minutes program, which also spoke to Deirdre's mother Faye Kennedy.

Carroll says he feels extremely sorry for Mrs Kennedy.

Nine says the results of the lie detector test will be revealed tonight in the program tonight, together with the interview.
